A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS SUPPORTING ALLOWING PRIVATELY OWNED VEHICLES TO USE SAN LUIS PORT II PORT OF ENTRY

Whereas the City of San Luis is experiencing long wait times for privately owned passenger vehicles at San Luis Port I, for crossing both from Mexico and to Mexico, despite the creation of a SENTRI Lane and a Ready Lane;

Whereas needed and necessary improvements to both sides of the border at San Luis Port I which would allow a decrease in wait times will not occur in the near future;

Whereas there is increased traffic crossing the border during the fall and winter seasons;

Whereas allowing privately owned vehicles to cross at San Luis Port II will help alleviate traffic congestion in the City of San Luis in the short term;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis that the City of San Luis is fully supportive of the efforts of U.S. Custom and Border Protection to open up San Luis Port II to privately owned vehicle traffic and staff is hereby instructed to take such actions as may be appropriate to support and implement this policy of the City.
